

Flipped Classroom

A flipped classroom is a pedagogical approach in which students gain necessary knowledge before class and faculties guide students to actively clarify and apply that knowledge during class. During class sessions, the students roll shift from passive recipients to the active constructors of knowledge. Faculties also prefer laboratories or places other than the classroom to teach students a particular topic. The faculties assign the topics of flipped class in advance and put the material like short lecture videos, images, animations or PowerPoint presentations in the study group through WhatsApp or e-mail for students to go through the material in advance. The faculty also discusses the questions and queries about the topic of students and builds additional knowledge on the subject during the class.

Objective: To enhance the student's learning and achievement by reversing traditional classroom teaching model.

Outcome: It Increases self- learning capabilities, stage daring, communication and working in team ability.
