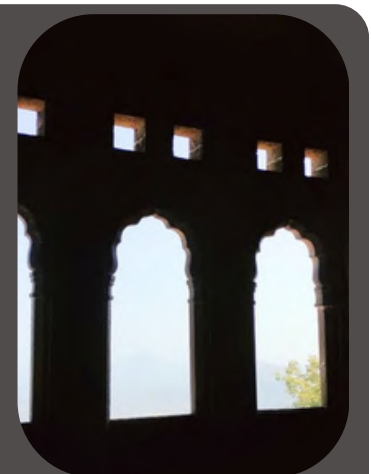


NANEGHAT AND SHIVNERI FORT

Finding My voice In A New City

This is not about someone but me. I came to Pune from Patna for college. I chose this city because my brother is settled here. Everything felt fine at first. New place, new start until I stepped into college and really looked around.

My peers were all from Maharashtra, born and brought up here. The teachers, the students, the conversations, everything was in Marathi. And honestly, what else was I expecting? I chose a college in Pune.

The language barrier hit me hard like a double decker bus. The first few weeks were overwhelming. I didn't understand anything. I didn't know anyone. For every sentence, sometimes even for a single word, I had to ask someone. People were helpful, yes, but no one really talked to me in the beginning.

And why would they? Why would they constantly switch languages and make an effort for an outsider?

It was strange. I could be around people, and yet no one would talk to me. I started to feel that I don't belong here. I felt invisible even when I was surrounded by people. Sitting in a group where I can't say anything because I don't understand, felt like someone took my voice away.

I built a wall without meaning to. A wall that stopped me from expressing myself. Socialising was never my strongest suit, and with all those "I don't belong here" feelings piled up, things only got worse.

But time passed. Slowly, I made friends, really good ones. People who want to talk to me, know me, understand me, and don't judge me for where I come from or which language I speak. That happened mostly because I started understanding their language.

Still, not everyone accepts you. And you learn to be okay with that. As more time passed, friends filled the space that those feelings had created.

In the end, I understood something simple but important: if you feel lonely in a crowd, maybe you're just standing in the wrong one. Change the people around you. Find those who align with your thoughts and values. That's when you begin to thrive like never before.
