7. **Objectives of the Event:**
 - a) Observe and understand real world business operations.
 - b) Gain insights into various industries and specific industrial practice.
 - c) Enhance academic learning through practical exposure.
 - d) Participate in a stock audit to gain hands-on experience in inventory verification.
 - e) Understand the manufacturing process of the industry.
 - f) Learn about the supply chain management practices and mechanisms.
 - g) Gain exposure to business practices and operations within the industry.

8. Content & schedule in details:

Students departed from the college at **7:00 am on Friday, 28/11/2025**, using the college-organized bus and reached **Bridgestone India Pvt. Ltd., Chakan MIDC** at around **9:00 am**. The visit began with an orientation session where students were introduced to the facility layout and warehouse operations. The main activity involved dividing students into small groups of 2, 3, and 4 for **hands-on audit exposure**, during which they actively participated in **stock checking and inventory verification** inside the warehouse. They further learned about the company's **manufacturing processes** and gained insights into **Supply Chain Management**, observing how materials move from procurement to distribution. After completing the full-day engagement, the group departed from Bridgestone in the afternoon/evening and returned to the college by approximately **5:45 pm**.
