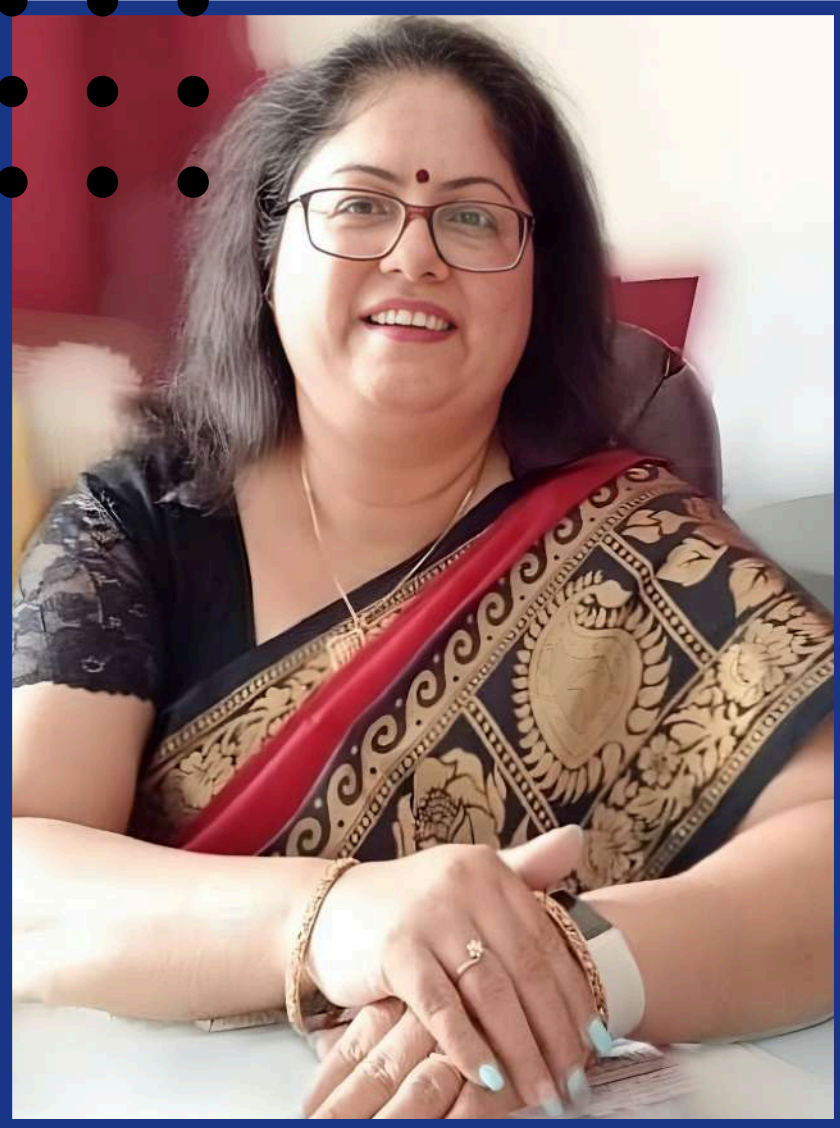

BBA TREK TO DURGA TEKDI

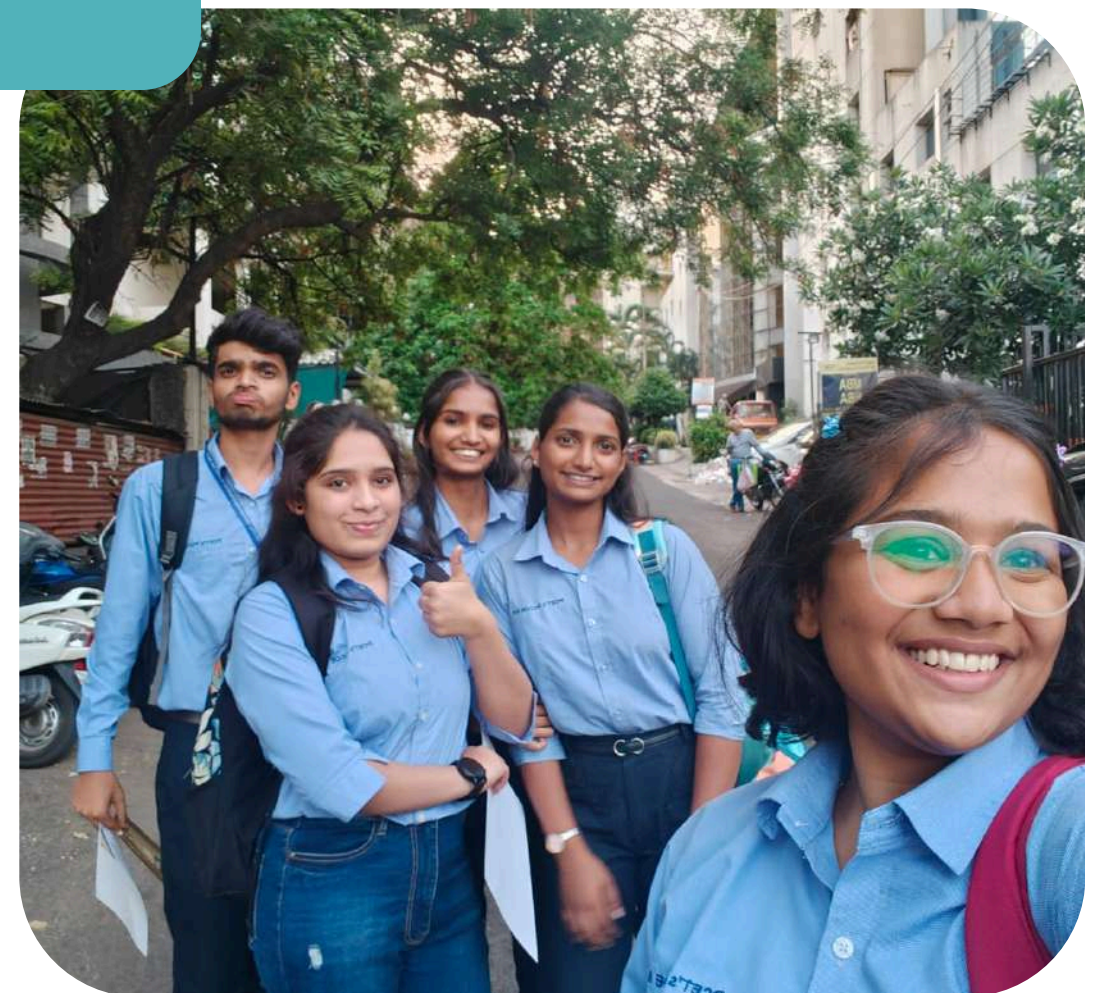
For Hiking
