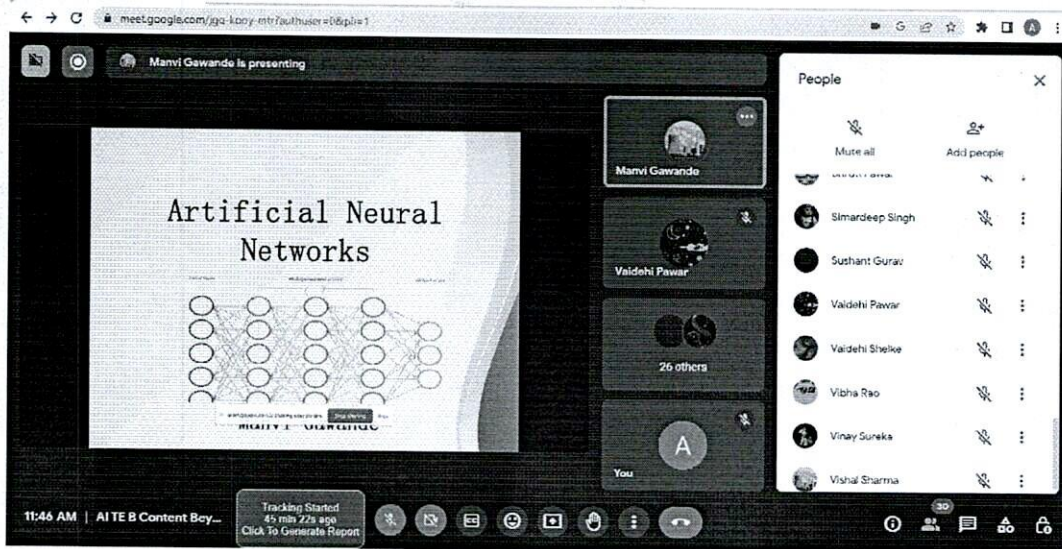

Outcome of the Event/Activity Conducted:

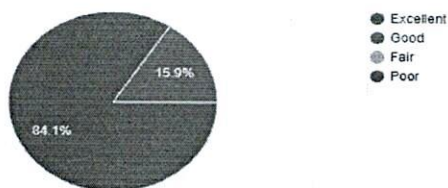
Peer learning activities between senior students and junior students offer several advantages for both groups. Here are some of the benefits:
