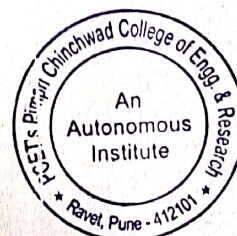

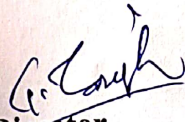

Instructions to Candidates (Round I)

1. Candidates whose names appear in the above Round I Provisional Merit List must log in to the official portal <https://fn.mahacet.org> and exercise one of the options below between 18-08-2026 and 20-08-2026 (up to the last date). Failure to do so within this window will result in the candidate being excluded from the admission process, and the eligibility fee (USD 50) and one-time processing fee (USD 1,150) already paid shall stand forfeited and non-refundable.
2. Option 1 - Seat allotted as per first preference: The candidate must Accept the seat and pay the final college fee through online mode. This acceptance is final, and the candidate shall not be eligible to participate in any subsequent round.
3. Option 2 - Seat allotted other than first preference, and candidate is satisfied (Freeze): The candidate must Accept the seat and pay the final college fee through online mode. This acceptance is final, and the candidate shall not be eligible to participate in any subsequent round.
4. Option 3 - Seat allotted other than first preference, and candidate wishes to be considered for a higher preference (Betterment): The candidate must Accept the allotted seat with the "Betterment" option and pay the applicable part-payment of the college fee through online mode. A candidate exercising Betterment after Round I may be upgraded, or may retain the present seat, in Round II only — this is the maximum wait available for a Round I allottee. Note: if upgraded in Round II, the seat presently held will stand automatically forfeited and released.



5. All fee payments must be made strictly in USD, through the designated nodal account or directly to the college as applicable, on or before the deadlines specified above. The final college fee, once paid to confirm a seat, is non-refundable under any circumstances.
6. Candidates are required to upload/verify all supporting documents on the portal as instructed. Original documents must be produced for physical verification at the time of reporting to the College; admission stands provisional until document verification is completed by the College.
7. New candidates seeking consideration in Round II must complete online registration on <https://fn.mahacet.org> on or before 25-08-2026. The Round II Provisional Merit List will be published on 28-08-2026.
8. Candidates are advised to regularly check the College website and the <https://fn.mahacet.org> portal for further updates regarding the admission schedule, document verification, and fee payment process.
